We are honored to invite you to participate in the International Scientific and Practical Conference and in Summer School activities «**Early Intervention: from theory to practice**». This action is aimed to discussing: the theoretical foundations of early intervention programs, the practical successful experience of early and permanent assistance to infants and their families in various countries and in the regions of the Russian Federation; a problems in training of young specialists (researchers and practical workers in the field of medicine, pedagogics, social work), of parents and volunteers.

Within the framework of the Conference & Summer School activities the experience of organizing early assistance in Australia, Portugal, Belarus, Azerbaijan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkey and other countries will be presented as well as the introduction of «St. Petersburg Model of Early Intervention», originating 25 years ago from the city social program «Habilitation of Infants» (1992) headed by specialists from Pavlov Institute of Physiology of the Russian Academy of Sciences professor Ludmila Chistovich and PhD (Biology) Elena Kozhevnikova.

Content of the Conference & School activities relates to the social importance and the economic validity (investing in human capital) of early intervention, and organization of interdepartmental and interdisciplinary scientific, practical and educational cooperation for implementing of the main points of Concept for the Development of Early Aid in Russia up to 2020, approved by the Government of the Russian Federation.

The events will be held in the form of lectures, reports, workshops and master-classes of leading experts in the field of early intervention (personal or distant presence) on a wide range of themes:

- interdepartmental and interdisciplinary cooperation,
- organization of medical rehabilitation in the departments of reanimation and pathology of newborns,
- support of children of the group of biological risk,
- assessment of the effectiveness of early interdisciplinary care,
- organization of habilitation and rehabilitation of disabled children,
- practical application of the «International Classification of Functioning, Disability and Health (ICF)» (WHO),
- home visits,
- problems of developmental pediatrics and profile education,
- other important aspects of early care for children and their families.

Emphasis will be done on complex problems related to the provision of adequate care to premature infants, and on the training of highly qualified specialists.

All activities will take place in two institutions:

- The Pavlov Institute of Physiology, Russian Academy of Sciences (St. Petersburg, emb. Makarova, 6)
- The Saint-Petersburg State Pediatric Medical University, Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation (St. Petersburg, Litovskaya st., 2)

For the participants of the Conference & School the excursion to I. P. Pavlov Museum (in St. Petersburg and in Koltushi village) and visiting of the laboratories of the Pavlov Institute of Physiology, Russian Academy of Sciences, St. Petersburg Early Intervention Institute, the Department of Medical Rehabilitation in the Perinatal Center of the St. Petersburg State Medical University will be additionally organized.
